In the case of any deviations, ensuring corrective steps to avoid pollution, work accidents and exceptional events. The role is also responsible for Good Manufacturing Practises compliance.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide solicited and unsolicited advice thus helping to continuously improve the Environmental, Health and Safety performance of the sites; ensure close co-ordination with SCM, Operations, Maintenance and R&D teams to execute on Perpetual Next specific initiatives.
- Promote a culture that enhances behavioural awareness through coaching and by challenging unsafe practices and behaviour both on the work floor as on management level.
- Assist with developing, coordinating and issuing training and instructions regarding variety of EHS topics.
- Responsible to check and corporate procedures and instruction on local laws and regulations and implement into a pragmatic policy for the Perpetual Next plants.
- Responsible for root cause analysis investigation and corrective and preventative actions for environmental deviations, incidents and customer complaints. Ensure corrective actions are timely and effective.
- Ensure that established SHEQ Management Systems are implemented and maintained in accordance with ISO 9001 (Quality), ISO 14001 (Environment) standards and applicable Laws and Regulations. Responsible for securing and continuously improving the quality systems in accordance with aforementioned standards and applicable Laws and Regulations.
- Ensure all third party certifications are kept current.
- Initiate, prepare and handle permit applications, environmental reports and management assessments.
- Liaise with suppliers to ensure consistent supply of quality raw materials which meet regulatory requirements.
- Building and maintaining constructive relationships with external parties, including municipalities, environmental services, customers, suppliers, laboratories and certification bodies.
- Supervising audits and, if necessary, taking care of the handling of corrective and preventative measurements.

- Ensure alignment of site SHEQ programs with overall business goals and oversee their execution.
- Direct the development and implementation of the SHEQ system(s), report performance of the SHEQ system; develop action plans for continuous improvement and ensure execution of the same.
- Promote Safety, Health, Environmental & Quality awareness internally by training and direct support to employees, departments, project teams, etc.
- Support quality control and material qualification functions.
- Partner with other sites to implement best practices.
- Establish and maintain SHEQ metrics for the site.
- Plan and execute the annual budget for the SHEQ department.
